Dental, Ayush and Pharmacy colleges in Karnataka State

This Authority is constituted to enforce the standards and procedures prescribed by the State Government to be followed by the Association of unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions non- minority or minority, as the case may be, and to supervise and oversee the admissions made by the said Institutions. In order to ensure that it is fair, transparent and non-exploitative.

It is seen that in the ongoing admissions there are instances of many aberrations, especially in the matter of collection of fees. In this regard Consensual Agreements have been entered into between the Government of Karnataka and the following Associations namely:

- (i) Association of Minority Professional Colleges in Karnataka,
- (ii) The Karnataka Linqustic Minority Professional Association,
- (iii) Karnataka unaided Private Engineering Colleges Association,
- (iv) Karnataka Professional Colleges Foundation.

-in the matter of seat sharing and fee structure.

- (i) In so far as **Engineering and Architecture Courses** are concerned, the Consensual Agreements prescribe the following fee structure and percentage of seats :

(v) In so far as Ayush Courses Note: The fee structure for Ayush courses was applied in respect of the academic year 2016-17. In so far as the academic year 2017-18, is concerned, there is a proposed revision said to be pending before the State Government and hence the decision of the Government is awaited for the final Fee Structure.

The State Government by its order dated 06.07.2010 No.HFW 131 PTD 2010 has prescribed the following:

Fees prescribed for Undergraduate Courses:

a) Government seats in Aided colleges	Rs.18590/- (Out of this, Rs.4410/- shall be considered as development fees)
b) Government seats in Unaided colleges	Rs.28,590/-
c) Management seats	Up to Rs.1,00,000/-

Note: Such other fees duly approved by the Government, or notified by the concerned Universities.

Fees prescribed for Post graduate Courses:

a) Government seats in Aided and unaided colleges	Rs.50,000/- per year
b) Management seats in Aided and unaided colleges	Rs.2,00,000/- per year upper limit

(vi) In so far as Pharmacy Courses are concerned, the State Government by its order dated 19.06.2014 No.HFW 188 PTD 2010 has prescribed the following, which shall be applicable for a period of Five years ending with the academic year 2018-19.

It is further noticed that, in so far as the Engineering and Architecture seats are concerned, the institutions are to earmark 5% of the total seats sanctioned as supernumerary seats and the education fees payable is waived under tuition fee waiver schemes, for admission of meritorious students, whose parents' income is less than Rs.6 lakh, based on merit.

These students shall only be liable to pay the fees fixed by the University, from time to time, to the Karnataka Examination Authority.

If there are no students to fill up these seats the same cannot be converted into the COMED-K quota or the Management quota and shall not even be considered for lateral entry for diploma students.

The list of students admitted under the supernumerary quota shall be sent to the concerned colleges and the Director of Technological Education through the Karnataka Examination Authority and such list shall be shared with this Authority, as well.

There is no provision for change of course or college, for the supernumerary quota students.

The details of admissions under the supernumerary quota shall be published in the website of the college. The above conditions as regards payment of fees and the waiver scheme of such fees has been reiterated and emphasized by the State Government by its order dated 24.06.2017 bearing NO. ED 160 TEC 2016 Bengaluru.

It is further specified in the said Government Order that the seats remaining unfilled after the final round of K.E.A counselling shall be handed over to the respective colleges after reconciliation and those seats could be filled up by the other students.

The Consensual Agreement prescribes the percentage of the seats to be shared and 25% of the intake, fixed for admission of NRI (15% NRI and 10%). Management and for minority Private institutions the same being 30%,(20% NRI and 10% Management quota). The said percentage shall not in any case be exceeded.

It is further brought to the attention of the concerned institutions that under the Consensual Agreements in respect of Medical and Dental Colleges, it is agreed by the respective Associations and the State Government that any dispute or litigation either in relation to the seat sharing formula or Fee Structure, or any other issues connected thereto, the decision of this Committee shall be final.

It is further noticed that there are large number of instances where candidates have chosen to withdraw from the seat allotted and take up either a different course of study or move to another college. The institutions who would have collected the original documents in the first instance refuse to return the documents on one pretext or the other and thereby seek to collect fees for the entire course, as a condition for return of the original documents. This is impermissible and the U.G.C. has issued strict guidelines as to the manner of remittance and refund of fees as well as the return of original documents. A copy of the said Notification has already been circulated to all the institutions.

The Karnataka Examination Authority has also issued a Notification as regards to remittance and refund of fees as well as prohibition of retention of students' testimonials. Violation of which would attract punitive action by the University Grants Commission as well as this Authority.

Hence, please note in the event of complaints as regards the breach of the terms and conditions under which the admissions are to be made this Authority shall initiate action under the provisions of Karnataka Professional Educational Institution (Regulation of Admission and Determination of Fee) Act, 2006. Apart from taking recourse to invoke the provisions of the Karnataka Educational, Institutions (Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1984, wherever there are instances found of collection of fees exceeding the prescribed limits. While also initiating

action under the provisions of the University Grants Commission (Grievance Redressal) Regulations 2012 in respect of remittance and refund of fees and other student centric issues. A Notification in that regard issued by the University Grants Commission has already been forwarded to your institution.

Please note this communication will be widely publicized and will be available in the public domain. Therefore, any complaints by students or their guardians will be summarily dealt with and acted upon, which will visit the erring institutions with serious punitive action from several quarters, of which be warned.

In the light view of the above, the following instructions are issued to all the Principals:

- (i) The students allotted to their colleges by the K.E.A shall be admitted forthwith without insisting on any additional fees other than the fees prescribed by the concerned Universities.
- (ii) The original documents after verification shall be returned to the students.
- (iii) The original documents if retained by the colleges shall be returned to the concerned student immediately. Under no circumstances shall the request of the student for return of the original documents and refund of fees be refused or delayed .
- (iv) Collection of the entire course fee from the student who leaves the course on account of allotment of another college or course or on his own accord, is prohibited and would invite punitive action under the U.G.C. (Grievance Redressal) Regulations, 2012, apart

from action by this Authority under the provisions of Karnataka Professional Educational Institution (Regulation of Admission and Determination of Fee) Act, 2006 and warranting recourse to the provisions of the Karnataka Educational, Institutions (Prohibition of Capitation Fee) Act, 1984.

- (v) Collection of tuition fees from students belonging to the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe categories is against the policy of the Government and the law.

The Principals are cautioned against the above said practices and warned that any such incident brought to the attention of this Authority will entail immediate punitive action.
