

CIRCULAR

It has come to the notice of the Government that the management^s of some of the private Engineering colleges are demanding excess fee instead of the fee fixed by the Government, from the students who have been allotted Government seats in private Engineering Colleges for the current academic year 2012-13. This action on the part of the private Engineering Colleges is totally against the terms of the consensual agreement signed by the managements with the Government.

In this connection, all the Engineering Colleges affiliated to Visvesvaraya Technological University, are strictly instructed **"not to demand excess fee from the students who have been allotted seats by Karnataka Examination Authority against the Government quota seats in private Engineering Colleges"**. If any complaint in this regard is received by the Government, the Government will be constrained to view the same seriously and will be compelled to initiate stringent action against such of the Institutions who demand excess fee, which may include appropriate recommendations against the managements to AICTE and other regulatory authorities.
