Instructions to Candidates

1. Use of any calculator or log table etc is prohibited.
2. There are no negative marks for incorrect answers.
3. The eligible candidates have to compulsorily appear for CET-2016 as per the schedule to become eligible for further process of determination of merit / admission to Professional Courses.
4. The names of the candidates will not be included in Merit list and will not be considered for further process of admission who fails to appear for either PCM or PCB subjects. Further, candidates can appear for all the four subjects i.e., PCMB.
5. Mere appearing for CET-2016 does not confer any right on the candidate for determination of merit / admission.
6. Candidates will not be allowed to carry ANY Modern Electronic Equipments, Gadgets, Pagers, Mobile Phones, Bluetooth, Markers, White Fluid, Calculator, Wireless sets, bits of paper, books / note etc. into the Examination Hall. The candidate (s) found in possession of any of these items in the examination hall will be treated as unfair means and his / her result will not be declared.
- 7. The candidates are not allowed to wear any type of wrist watch in the examination hall / room.**
8. The candidate should note that their candidature is strictly provisional. The mere fact that Admission Ticket has been issued and the candidate is allowed to appear for the examination shall not imply that KEA has finally accepted his / her candidature.
- 9. Along with the CET-2016 Admission Ticket candidate has to carry any one valid Identity Card like Passport, Aadhar Card, PAN Card, College Identity Card, 2nd PU / 12th Std Examination Admission Ticket.**
10. The candidates have to follow the instructions given by the invigilators in the examination hall / room and should not argue with the invigilators or other staff involved in the examination duty at the examination centre. The candidates, who will not follow the instructions, will be treated as unfair means and his / her result will not be declared.
11. Read the instructions given in the Admission Ticket.

12. No candidate will be allowed to appear at the examination centre other than that allotted to him / her in the admission ticket.
13. Any candidate writes / shades anything other than the required entries, which may result in disclosing the candidate identity, or use of abusive language or employ any other unfair means, such as change of marking answers by scratching or using white fluid, such candidate's are liable for disqualification.
14. The candidate should not carry more than two / three ball point pens (blue / black) to the examination hall and also they should not carry pencil with them to the examination hall.
