

All eligible candidates are requested to enter their priority of options from **8.00 pm on 16-09-2013 to 18-09-2013 up to 9.00 am** in order to be considered for allotment of seats for PG courses for the Second and final Round.

While entering the options or deleting options candidate should be very careful because the priority of options will be considered for allotment of seats.

The Second Round Seat Allotment status will be hosted on the KEA website <http://kea.kar.nic.in> on **19-09-2013 after 6.00 pm** for the information of the candidates.

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES FOR OPTION ENTRY

SECOND AND FINAL ROUND SEAT ALLOTMENT

- ❖ The option entry for the second round of counselling will be from 8.00 pm on 16-09-2013 up to 9.00 am on 18-09-2013.
- ❖ All eligible PG rank holders can participate in the second and final round.
- ❖ All candidates are requested to enter fresh options in the second round if they wish to participate in the second round.
- ❖ Candidates who are satisfied with the allotted seat and who are not interested / willing to participate in the second round need not enter any options in the option entry. The allotted seat in the first round will be confirmed.
- ❖ If a candidate is willing to participate in the second round he / she must enter options afresh. If the candidate gets a seat in the colleges opted by him / her in the second round, the seat opted by him / her in the second round will be confirmed and the seat held by him in the first round will automatically gets cancelled and the same will be allotted to next eligible candidate.
- ❖ If the candidate does not get any seat in the second round then the seat allotted to him / her in the first round stands confirmed.
- ❖ The seat allotted in the first round will be the considered as last option and the options entered by the candidates in this round will become better options. This will ensure that if better options are not allotted, the seat allotted to them will be retained and the same will be confirmed.

- ❖ The seat allotted in the first round will not be shown in the option entry in the second round, but the same will be considered as the last option during second round.
- ❖ All the candidates are requested to give as many options as possible even though the seat matrix does not show any vacancy. This is because consequential vacancies may arise during allotment process and the candidates will have a chance of getting a better seat if they have entered the options.

NOTE: Consequential vacancies that arise after their turn cannot be claimed.

- ❖ All candidates who have been allotted afresh in the second round or those who have confirmed the seat first round shall compulsorily join the colleges after making payment and report to KEA portal for confirmation otherwise seat gets cancelled.
- ❖ The seat of a candidate who has paid the fees for the seat allotted in the first round and whether reported to the college or not will be in his / her favour only. If they get a better seat in this round then the seat allotted to them in the first round will be gets cancelled or if they fail to get a new seat in this round, the earlier seat will be in their favour.
- ❖ Please note that if any seat gets allotted in this round as per merit and options entered by the candidate, **there is no chance of getting back the earlier allotted seat because the seat released by the candidate will be treated as consequential vacancy and will be offered to the next eligible candidates.**

The following types of seats are added to the seat matrix for second round allotment.

- a. All Unfilled seats.
- b. All Cancelled / Surrendered seats.
- c. Candidates allotted seat in the first round but failed to make payment (except for SC / ST)
- d. Choice 3 Seats
- e. Choice 4 Seats
- f. Newly added seats.
- g. Consequential seats during allotment.
