

PGCET-2017

- ✓ The PGCET-2017 will be held in one session separately for **MBA**, conducted for 100 marks with 150 minutes duration. There will be **100** questions and each question will carry ONE mark.
- ✓ The PGCET-2017 will be held in one session separately for **MCA** courses conducted for 100 marks with 150 minutes duration. 60 questions in Part - A carry one mark each. 20 questions in Part - B carry two marks each. Thus there will be **80** questions and a total mark is 100.
- ✓ The PGCET-2017 will be held in two sessions separately for Type – A and Type-B of **ME / M.Tech / M.Arch.** courses conducted 100 marks with 150 minutes duration. Total Number of Questions:**75**
- ✓ OMR Answer Sheet is common for all the subjects / courses. Candidate has to mark the answers against the questions as per the questions printed in the question paper for respective subjects. Study the OMR answer sheet hosted on the KEA Website.

Additional Instructions

1. Use of any calculator or log table etc is prohibited.
2. There are no negative marks for incorrect answers.
3. The eligible candidates have to compulsorily appear for the Examination as per the schedule to become eligible for further process of admission. The names of the candidate will not be included Merit list and will not be considered for further admission process who fails to appear for the examination.
4. Mere appearing for Examination does not confer any right on the candidate for admission.
5. Candidates will not be allowed to carry ANY Modern Electronic Equipments, Pagers, Mobile Phones, Bluetooth, Markers, White Fluid, Calculator, Wireless sets, bits of paper, books / note etc. into the Examination Hall. The candidate (s) found in possession of any of these items in the examination hall will be treated as unfair means and his / her result will not be declared.
6. **Only Non-Programmable Calculators are allowed only for M.E. / M.Tech / M.Arch. examination.**
7. The candidates are not allowed to wear any type of watch in the examination hall / room.
8. The candidate should note that their candidature is strictly provisional. The mere fact that Admission Ticket has been issued and the candidate is allowed to appear for the examination shall not imply that the KEA has finally accepted his / her candidature.
9. Along with the Admission Ticket candidate has to carry any one valid Identity Card like College Identity Card, Bus Pass, Driving License, Passport, Aadhar Card, PAN Card, Voter ID.
10. The candidates have to follow the instructions given by the invigilators in the examination hall / room and should not argue with the invigilators or other staff involved in the examination duty at the examination centre. The candidates, who will not follow the instructions, will be treated as unfair means and his / her result will not be declared.
11. No candidate will be allowed to appear at the examination centre other than that allotted to him / her in the admission ticket.
12. The candidate should not carry more than two / three ball point pens (blue / black) to the examination hall and also they should not carry pencil with them to the examination hall.
