

Document Verification for the candidates eligible as per the reduced
qualifying percentile to PG Medical Courses – 2017-18

Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, New Delhi in their order V. 11025/18/2017-MEP dated 24-05-2017, have lowered the qualifying percentile of NEET PG 2017. Director, Medical Education in their letter dated 24-05-2017 has requested KEA to conduct verification of documents to those candidates who may become eligible due to lowering of percentile for admission to PG Medical Courses for Government seats & Government quota in Private colleges. The details of qualifying percentile for admission to PG Medical Courses can be seen on the NBE Website.

Therefore, such interested eligible candidates have to attend the document verification with all the relevant original documents along with a DD for Rs.1,000/- (DD in the name of Executive Director, KEA payable at Bangalore) on 27-05-2017 between 10.30 am to 1.30 pm.

The candidates who become eligible after verification of documents will be considered for allotment of PG Medical seats in the offline counseling on 28-05-2017 for available Government Seats & Government quota in Private colleges on 28th May 2017.

The eligible candidates have to submit all the relevant original documents for verification with one set of attested photocopies. Please read e-brochure for submission of mandatory documents.

The Karnataka candidates who are claiming reservation benefit should produce the relevant caste / caste income certificate. The PWD candidates should produce the doctor certificate for verification.

No individual intimation will be sent to the candidates in this regard.

NOTE:

Those candidates who were having the qualifying eligibility percentile before the modification of eligibility percentile by Competent Authority, but failed to register / verify the original documents for the first round seat allotment are not eligible to participate in this round.

1. The result of NEET-PG 2017 was declared on 13th January 2017. In accordance with Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India Notification **F.No V.12025/18/2017-MEP** dated 24th May 2017, the minimum qualifying percentiles have been revised as follows:

2. Candidates scoring more than or equal to the revised category-wise cut-off scores have been declared as qualified.
3. Qualified candidates have been assigned a unique Revised All India NEET-PG Rank in descending order of their scores and utilizing the tie breaker criteria mentioned in para 14.4 of NEET-PG 2017 Information Bulletin.

4. The revised score card of all the candidates who appeared in NEET-PG 2017 can be downloaded from NEET-PG website www.nbe.edu.in. The revised Score card will not be sent individually to the candidates. Candidates are requested to download their score cards from website www.nbe.edu.in.
5. Candidature is purely provisional subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria as mentioned in NEET-PG 2017 Information Bulletin.
6. There is no change in the result-cum-merit for NEET-PG 2017 - All India 50% quota MD/MS/ PG Diploma seats.
7. State Quota Seats: The revised result of NEET-PG 2017 shall also be shared with all States/UT of India. The final merit list/category wise merit list for State quota seats shall be generated by the States/UT/Institutes as per their qualifying/eligibility criteria, applicable guidelines/Regulations & reservation policy.
