

## **For the information of the candidate who have qualified in NEET-2017**

1. As per the eligibility criteria prescribed in PGET rules the candidates who have got the required percentile in the NEET-2017 (conducted by NBE) examination and who are having the eligibility to be considered under Karnataka Merit list can approach Karnataka Examinations Authority on or before 06.03.2017 (2.00 pm) with the necessary documents.
2. As per the present Notification, the candidates who are eligible under rules, might not have been able to register their names for PGET-2017 through online. For such candidates the present last date for registration which is on 01.03.2017 is extended upto 06.03.2017 ( 5.00 pm).
3. Further, the last date for payment of fees is also extended upto 07.03.2017 (bank hours) due to bank holidays and bank strike.
4. As per the eligibility criteria prescribed in PGET rules, the candidates who have completed the MBBS/BDS course in Karnataka are eligible to get enrolled if they have qualified in NEET-2017. Such candidates need not produce study certificate and domicile certificates.
5. The candidates of Karnataka origin who have completed the MBBS/BDS course outside Karnataka recognized by MCI/DCI and if candidate or either of his/her parents have studied/domiciled in Karnataka, are eligible to get enrolled for PGET-2017. Such candidates have to produce domicile certificate and/or study certificate as prescribed under the rules. (Ref. 1.3 of e-Brochure).
6. The candidates who are completing the internship by 31.03.2017 and who are unable to produce the PDC for verification of documents can produce PDC (only for candidates who have passed MBBS/BDS during 2016) at the time of submitting the original documents to Karnataka Examinations Authority after the first round of allotment, failing which the seat allotted to them, if any, will get cancelled.
