IT IS MANDATORY THAT ALL CANDIDATES SHALL TO PRODUCE A PRINT OUT OF ADMIT CARD & SCORE CARD ISSUED BY NBE FOR MEDICAL & DENTAL COURSES, KEA ONLINE REGISTRATION FORM AND COPY OF THE CHALLAN FOR HAVING PAID THE FEES ON THE DAY OF DOCUMENT VERIFICATION ALONG WITH OTHER RELEVANT DOCUMENTS PRESCRIBED HERE IN.

All candidates are directed to visit the website of KEA at least twice every day for updates. KEA or the Directorate of Medical Education or the Government shall not be responsible for any action/consequence /s resulting due to non-diligent follow up of notices, notifications and publications appearing on the KEA website for PGET 2017 by the Candidates.

The Government or Karnataka Examinations Authority or the Entrance Test Committee may from time to time specify for submission such other additional documents and issue directions as deemed essential for all Candidates for maintaining absolute transparency and integrity in the Document Verification Process, Determination of Eligibility and Seat Allotment and Admission- through a notification on the website of KEA.

IMPORTANT

Candidates are hereby informed to go through the Information Bulletin carefully and understand / acquaint themselves:-

1. Candidates can apply "Online" only for Karnataka State PGET-2017
2. Information Bulletin can be downloaded from the Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in>
3. Online submission of Application Form can be done by accessing KEA Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in>
4. Candidates must follow the instructions strictly as given in the Information Bulletin and on KEA Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in> Candidates not complying with the instructions shall summarily be disqualified.
5. Candidates must retain the following documents with them as reference for future correspondence.
 - (i) At least three printouts of the finally submitted online Application.
 - (ii) Online Fees Paid receipt copy
 - (iii) 3 copies of identical Photograph that is scanned and uploaded in the Online Application.
6. (a) Candidate must ensure that mobile numbers, e-mail address entered in the online application form are his / her own as in case of urgency KEA may send information / communications by SMS or email on given mobile number and email ID only.
(b) KEA will not be held responsible for non-receipt of latest information due to wrong mobile number or mailing address filled in the Online Application Form.

The Karnataka Examinations Authority, Bangalore is conducting Online Centralised Counselling for allotment of seats for admission to Post Graduate Degree / Diploma Courses in Medical / Dental courses as notified by the Government of Karnataka for the academic year 2017-18.

As per the instructions of (a) MCI in its letter No. 34(41) / 2016 dated 09-03-2017, (b) Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, GOI letter No. FV 11011/1/2015 MEP dated 10-03-2017 (c) Government of India Gazette Notification dated 11-03-2017, Director Medical Education, Karnataka vide letter No. DME / MCS / 11 / 2016-17 dated 16-03-2017 has requested Karnataka Examinations Authority (KEA) to invite applications online to conduct centralised and combined counselling for the seats to be notified by Government, in Government, COMED-K, KRLMPCA, AMPCK and Deemed University Colleges in the state of Karnataka for admission to Post Graduate Medical and Dental (Degree and Diploma) courses for the year 2017-18 (Excluding NRI / Management Quota seats).

Accordingly as per the decisions of the PG Entrance Test Committee, KEA is inviting applications online from the eligible, qualified in NEET-2017 candidates from all over India, for admission to Post Graduate Medical and Dental (Degree and Diploma) courses for the year 2017-18 in the state of Karnataka.

The academic eligibility criteria as laid down in NEET-2017 information brochure and other conditions are hosted on the KEA Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in> for the information of the candidates. The candidates who have scored more than or equal to the prescribed minimum score in NEET-2017 only are eligible to register for PG Admissions. Please note that SC/ST/OBC eligibility criteria are applicable to SC/ST/OBC Karnataka candidates only.

KEA is entrusted with document verification for determining the eligibility of the candidates as per the directions of the Government and the allocation of seats as per the Online seat Allotment and Admission Procedure. The results of Medical & Dental published by National Board of Examination (NBE), New Delhi in NEET-2017 will be taken into consideration for preparation of rank list after verification of original documents and allotment of seats to all eligible candidates for PG Medical & Dental seats.

I. ELIGIBILITY:

A candidate who fulfils the following criteria will be eligible to appear for the online seat allotment process, namely:-

A. Academic Eligibility

Candidates who obtain a minimum score in the PG Entrance Test conducted by National Board of Examinations, New Delhi as per category below are declared as "Qualified" in PGET-2017.

- i. ≥ 50 percentile in PGET for "General Merit" candidates

- ii. ≥ 40 percentile in PGET for "Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe & OBC" candidates (Karnataka candidates only)
- iii. ≥ 45 percentile in PGET for Persons with Disability candidates with Locomotor Disability of lower limbs between 40% to 70% (for Medical)
- iv. Inter Se merit
In case two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in the competitive entrance examination, their inter se merit will be determined as follows
 - (a) Marks Secured in NEET – Descending (1st Order)
 - (b) According to age, older will get preference over younger.(2nd Order)
 - (c) If candidates have secured same marks in NEET then Total No. of Attempts taken in UG – Ascending (3rd Order)
 - (d) If candidates have secured same marks in NEET & same Total No. of attempts taken in UG then % of total marks secured in UG – Descending (4th Order)
 - (e) If candidates have secured same marks in NEET, same Total No. of attempts taken in UG & same % of total marks in UG then % of final year marks secured in UG (5th Order)

Lower percentage / percentile of marks for SC/ST/OBC /PH is only for eligibility purpose and will be applicable to the candidates belonging to Karnataka only and there are no reservation quotas for these categories.

B. Other Eligibility

- i. He / She is a citizen of India.
- ii. Must be less than 45 years of age for non service as on 31st March 2017.
- iii. He / She has studied and passed in the courses leading to the award of MBBS / BDS Degrees in colleges recognized by Medical Council of India / Dental Council of India, Government of India and affiliated to any University established by law in India.
- iv. He / She have completed or are completing 'Compulsory Rotating Internship' on or before 31st March 2017.
- v. A candidate, who is already pursuing / holding a Post-Graduate degree in any specialty, shall not be eligible to appear for the online seat allotment counselling process for admission to any post Graduate Medical or Dental degree or Diploma Course.
- vi. A candidate, who is already holding a Post-Graduate Diploma in any specialty, shall be eligible for post graduate degree course in the same Specialty & shall not be eligible for any other post graduate degree or diploma courses.
- vii. Additional eligibility may apply for seats in the following institutions as per their institution admission policy.

For Religious Minority

Religious Minority (Christian) of Karnataka & Non Karnataka.

Religious Minority (Muslim) of Karnataka & Non Karnataka.

For Linguistic Minority

Linguistic minority (Tamil, Telugu, Kodava & Tulu) of Karnataka only.

For DEEMED universities

- Karnataka Domicile of Belagavi Revenue division for KLE University, Belagavi.
- Karnataka Domicile of Vijayapura District for BLDE University, Vijayapura (Bijapur).
- Karnataka Domicile of Mysuru & Chamarajanagar for JSS University, Mysuru.
- Muslim Minority for Yenepoya University, Mangalore.

II. MANDATORY CERTIFICATES / DOCUMENTS / FORMATS TO BE PRODUCED

All candidates appearing for document verification should produce the following in **Original Certificates** along with one set of self attested copy of all the required documents at the time of document verification. The originals certificates will be verified and returned to the candidates. **Under no circumstances the candidates will be allowed to participate in the verification process without the original documents / certificates / relevant Annexures .**

Other mandatory documents, if applicable.

If eligible / applicable the additional documents to be produced for (COMED K / AMPCK / KRLMPCK / Deemed Universities)

- i. Karnataka Domicile certificate issued by the concerned Tahasildar (candidate or either of his/her parent has been a resident of Karnataka State for a period of not less than TEN years) OR A study certificate for either of the parents having studied for at least 10 years in Karnataka from the Head of the educational institution where he/she had studied.
- ii. If claiming caste eligibility benefits: (only for Karnataka candidates) Caste/ Caste Income Certificate issued by Concerned Tahasildar- For SC/ST in Form-D, Category-I in Form-E and 2A, 2B, 3A and 3B in Form-F. (In case of married candidate, income of the spouse and his family to be included in the annual income, and in the case of married woman, certificate has to be in the name of candidate along with husband and including the income of the spouse family)
- iii. Certificates issued by the competent authority for claiming reservation under 371(j) (Hyderabad - Karnataka Region).
- iv. Certificate issued by the Competent Authority to claim Minority status (Religious / Linguistic) and domicile certificate.. **Annexure IV**

NOTE:

1. Linguistic Minority status is applicable only to Karnataka Candidates and Religious Minority status as applicable at All India Basis as per the prevailing rules.
2. If the issuing authority for i & iv certificates is other than Revenue Tahasildar, then an affidavit (to be typed on Rs.20/- Stamp Paper) to that effect has to be compulsorily produced along with the other certificates at the time of verification of documents.

Only on submission of the above prescribed document, the candidate's document verification process is stated to be completed and he /she becomes eligible for allocation of User ID and Secret Key (Verification Document acknowledgement).

The Government / Competent Authority / Karnataka Examinations Authority from time to time may specify for submission such other additional documents as deemed essential from all Candidates through the application form or through notification in website: <http://kea.kar.nic.in>

Further the Government of Karnataka, the Karnataka Examination Authority, the Directorate of Medical Education, and the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences reserve the right to cause any verification as deemed essential at any point of time into the originality and authenticity of any of the certificates produced by any candidate to fulfil and stake his/her claim to any of the qualifying and eligibility criteria. If on such verification it is found that the Candidate has produced fake, fraudulent certificates, he/she will be liable for criminal prosecution, immediate loss of allotted seat without any notice whatsoever, recovery of monetary compensation as may be decided by the PGET Committee, will be liable to be debarred from all exams in future besides the Government will recommend blacklisting of the Candidate to MCI/DCI/KMC and cancellation of license.

Candidature is purely provisional and subject to fulfilment of eligibility criteria as mentioned in the NEET-PG-2017 Information Bulletin further the provisional admission made is subject to approval of MCI / DCI / Government / Competent Authority / Universities / Deemed Universities etc. Mere registering or verifying the documents does not confer any right to the candidates for admission to Karnataka PG MD / MS / Diploma courses.

All NEET PG-2017 qualified candidates are allowed for participating in the allotment of PG Medical / Dental seats as per the **eligibility & reservation criteria** for the respective seats

These seats are classified into two categories.

1st Category: Government seats, means and includes seats in Government colleges and Government share of seats in Private colleges.

2nd Category: Private seats, means and includes seats in Private Colleges (Unaided, Minority, Deemed)

➤ **1st Category:** The candidates who are having the eligibility criteria on par with the “Karnataka Conduct of Entrance Test for Selection and Admission to Post Graduate Medical and Dental Degree and Diploma Courses Rules 2006 as amended from time to time and in July 2012, November 2013, December 2013 and January 2014, March 2016” are only eligible to select 1st category seats.

➤ **2nd Category:** All the candidates are eligible to select 2nd category seats as per the eligibility criteria of the respective institutions.

KEA has already conducted the document verification to the candidates belonging to 1st category, and if any such candidate who is willing to opt 2nd category seats, he / she need not attend the document verification once again to consider him / her for 2nd category seats.

However, such candidates if they are eligible to claim seats in these admission process, will be given an opportunity to submit the other certificates such as Minority (Linguistic / Religious) or Local domicile certificates or 371(j) certificates, then he / she has to submit the relevant certificate to establish proof for such claim. Document verification will be conducted for such candidates as per the schedule.

STAGES – FOR REGISTRATION AND DOCUMENT VERIFICATION

To commence the process for admission to Post Graduate Medical / Dental Degree and Diploma courses for the year 2017-18 in the institutions as notified by the Government of Karnataka the candidate has to go through the following stages.

1. Online Registration
2. Payment of Registration Fees
3. Biometric & Verification of Documents
4. Publication of Merit list

1. Online Registration.

The candidates who are qualified in NEET-2017 and who are aspiring PG Medical and Dental seats in the Karnataka State have to register online by visiting <http://kea.kar.nic.in>. All the details sought in the online registration form has to be entered by the candidates without fail. The details entered by the candidates will be the final for further process of admission.

2. Payment of Registration Fees

After completion of entry of details online, candidate has to pay the registration fees of Rs. 1,000/- (Rs.500/- in case of SC / ST / Cat-I of Karnataka), the mode of payment of fees is as follows:

(a) The candidates can download the Challan from the same link and pay the fees in the prescribed bank within Karnataka;

OR

(b) The candidates can pay the fees through online (internet banking / debit card / credit card)

NOTE: Filled registration form and a copy of the Challan / UTR details for having paid the fees should be compulsorily submitted along with the other documents at the time of verification.
