

## **NOTICE**

As per the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. (c) 267/2017 DAR-US-SLAM EDUCATIONAL TRUST and Ors. Vs. MEDICAL COUNCIL OF INDIA and Ors. dated 09.05.2017.

**"After the second round of counselling for All India Quota seats, the students who take admission in All India Quota seats should not be allowed/permitted to vacate the seats. This would ensure that very few seats are reverted to the State Quota and also All India Quota seats are filled by students from the all India merit list only. The students who take admission and secure admission in Deemed Universities pursuant to the second round of counselling conducted by the DGHS shall not be eligible to participate in any other counselling."**

In this regard, all the counselling authorities (State/NBE) are hereby informed that as per the directions in the W.P. (c) 267/2017, all those candidates who have taken admission/joined the allotted seat in second round of the online counselling for 50% All India Quota & Deemed Universities are not eligible to participate in any other counselling for State Quota/DNB.

Further, counselling authorities are hereby directed not to allow such candidates in their counselling to avoid any legal complications and contempt of the court.
