

Instructions to Candidates Attending
Mop-up round seat allotment – PGET-2018

PG Medical - 16th and 17th May 2018

PG Dental -18th May 2018

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. All candidates who wish to attend mop-up round should possess ENTRY PASS, Verification Slip and Acknowledgement Slip for having submitted the Original documents. No candidate will be allowed for mop-up round without the ENTRY PASS to KEA premises.
2. Candidate alone will be allowed to enter the seat allotment hall. Candidate will not be allowed to exit from the seat allotment hall for any reason before completion of his / her turn.
3. Entry to seat allotment hall will be on the basis of merit. However, the candidates will have to wait for their turn for allotment of seats.
4. ENTRY PASS should be submitted at the registration counter itself.
5. Parents or any other relatives / guardians are not allowed to accompany the candidate during seat selection.
6. No one can represent the candidate for seat selection.
7. Candidates who are registering and attending the document verification on 14th May 2018 should collect the ENTRY PASS from the Verification Counter itself after verification and submission of original documents.
8. Candidates should bring the required fees in the form of Demand Draft drawn in f/o "The Executive Director, KEA", payable at Bangalore, in multiple denominations as per your desired seat.
9. All PG Medical aspirants should report to KEA on 16th May 2018 itself by 9.00 am and PG Dental aspirants by 9.00 am on 18th May 2018.
10. Last date for college admission is 21-05-2018.

Instructions to candidates allotted PG Medical pre / para seats and non-clinical (Oral Pathology and Public / Community Dentistry) PG Dental seats.

1. Candidates who have been allotted and not joined Pre / Para clinical Medical seats and non-clinical Dental seats (Oral Pathology and Public / Community Dentistry) are eligible to participate in the Mop-up round. (Candidates who have already reported to the allotted college are not eligible to participate)
2. Candidates who have been allotted but not joined PG Medical Pre / Para clinical seats and non-clinical Dental seats (Oral Pathology and Public / Community Dentistry) must compulsorily register for mop-up round and download the ENTRY PASS. If they fail to register for mop-up round already allotted seat gets cancelled automatically in the mop-up round without further notice.
3. Candidates who have been already allotted PG Medical pre / para clinical subjects / PG Dental non-clinical subjects in second round of counseling, if a clinical seat is allotted, has to pay the relevant applicable fees in the form of Demand Draft (if not paid) and complete the admission process.
4. Candidates who have been allotted PG Medical pre / para clinical subjects / PG Dental non-Clinical subjects in second round of counseling, if a clinical seat is NOT allotted then they have to pay the fees (if not paid) and collect the **FRESH admission order** for pre / para clinical seat already allotted in the second round.
5. Candidates, who have been allotted PG Medical pre / para clinical subjects / PG Dental non-Clinical subjects in second round of counseling, if they don't wish to join, should exit with penalty giving an undertaking of cancellation of seat to KEA in the prescribed format.
