### PGET-2020 - NOTE ON MOCK ALLOTMENT RESULTS

1. Based on the options entered by the candidates in the order of merit and by following the Roaster System MOCK SEAT ALLOTMENT has been carried out and mock seat allotment results are published.
2. Candidates are required to verify their allotted seat status on the KEA Website <http://kea.kar.nic.in>, if they desire they are free to alter / reorder / modify / delete / add the options of their choices of courses / colleges as per their preference.
3. All the candidates must enter their final options before the last date and time prescribed. Candidates will not be able to enter their priority of options again after the last date and time fixed to do so.
4. Even though the candidate may not like to modify the options after the **Mock Allotment, he / she may NOT get the same seat** during the Real Allotment as other candidates may change their earlier entered options.
5. The mock test is only to help the candidates familiarize and show them the **course and college allotted to them and it should be in no way presumed that same seat and college will be allotted to them in the actual allotment of seats**. Because, the candidates have the option of changing the priority of the options entered by them after the mock allotment.
6. This Mock Seat Allotment is only an INDICATIVE seat status which candidate may or may not get in the real allotment. It will help the candidate to revise, update, add or delete already the entered options.
7. The candidates should not report to the college allotted in the Mock Seat Allotment, but they have to wait for the real seat allotment.
8. Eligible candidates, who have not entered their options till now, can also enter their priority of options before the last date and time prescribed.
9. Candidates will also be able to view the details of seat allotted as per their options priority. Candidates can also view the College-wise, Course-wise, Category-wise cut off rank of Mock Allotment.
10. The candidate's, who have not allotted any seat in the Mock allotment, should verify the options entered by them and are advised to enter more options to which they are interested and eligible.
