NOTIFICATION

Inviting applications online for Admission to MBBS and BDS courses for the year 2021-22 in the State of Karnataka and for admission to AYUSH courses to Karnataka Candidates

- Government vide letter No. MED 173 RGU 2021 dated 09-12-2021 has directed KEA to
- commence the process of inviting applications online and conduct document verification for admission to UG Medical and Dental courses for the year 2021-22 in the State of Karnataka. Accordingly, as per the directions of the Government, KEA will be inviting applications online for admissions to Medical and Dental courses for the year 2021-22. The candidates who
- have scored more than or equal to the prescribed minimum score in UGNEET-2021 only are eligible to register and apply online for UG Medical and Dental courses for the year 2021-22. Karnataka candidates can also apply for Government share of AYUSH seats. Non-
- Karnataka candidates are not eligible for AYUSH admissions through KEA.
- Non-Karnataka candidates will not be eligible for reservation. Hence, in the UGNEET-2021 examination, if they have scored the required minimum 50th percentile or above, fixed for 'GENERAL (UR)' category as per the qualifying criteria, then only they are eligible to register
- for admissions through KEA or for any other seats in the State of Karnataka. Please note that SC/ST/OBC eligibility criteria are applicable to Karnataka SC/ST/OBC candidates only. Before registering through online for admission to Medical and Dental courses in the state of

Karnataka, applicants are hereby informed to read the Information Bulletin UGNEET-2021 and understand the eligibility conditions, classification of seats (different types of category of

- seats) and eligibility to claim such seats which are hosted on the KEA Website http://kea.kar.nic.in for the information of the candidates. The interested eligible candidates can register through online & enter the details online from 2.00 pm on 13-12-2021 to 17-12-2021 upto 11.59 pm by selecting the appropriate link in the KEA Website. Last date to pay the registration fees is
- 18-12-2021 before 5.30 pm. Registration fee, schedule for verification of documents, original documents to be produced
- verification and other details will be hosted on the KEA Website. Interested eligible candidates can register and apply online and appear for document verification as per the schedule.

The candidates who have already registered for CET-2021 and completed the document

ENTRY OF UGNEET-2021 ROLL NUMBER BY KARNATAKA CANDIDATES WHO HAVE ALREADY VERIFIED THEIR DOCUMENTS

verification, have to enter their correct UGNEET-2021 Roll Number from 2.00 pm on 13-12-2021 to 17-12-2021 upto 11.59 pm through the online link enabled in KEA Web-portal to become eligible for admission to Medical, Dental and AYUSH courses. However, such candidates need not pay the registration fee once again. Further, they should check the NEET Roll number printed on the Application Form after entering the UGNEET – 2021 Roll Number.

Candidates, who have assigned ranks in CET-2021 and completed their document

- verification as per CET-2006 Admission Rules, and those who are not claiming any additional reservation need not appear for verification of documents once again Medical / Dental / AYUSH courses. But they have to download the UGNEET-2021 Verification slip from KEA portal on the specified dates to become eligible for admission to Medical/Dental/AYUSH courses.
- However, if any such candidate is eligible to claim reservation as per Government of Karnataka norms or under Linguistic Minority / Religious Minority / NRI WARD or candidates eligible to claim seats under Category-2 to Category-8 in St. John Medical College, Bangalore, they have to claim such reservations in the online application form and they have to appear for document verification with all the relevant original certificates / documents
- **INSTRUCTIONS TO NON-KARNATAKA CANDIDATES** Non-Karnataka candidates who have qualified in UGNEET 2021, they have to first register through online in KEA Web-portal, enter all the details, and pay the registration fee. Further

they have to enter the 12th standard marks details and upload in PDF format in the same web

portal. They need not appear for verification of documents. However, OCI / PIO / NRI / Foreign Nationals and if any non-Karnataka candidates eligible to claim NRI Ward, Religious Minority or eligible to claim under category-2 to category-8 in St. John Medical College, Bangalore, then they have to appear for verification of documents at KEA, Bangalore on the specified dates.

- Government in their letter No. HFW 124 RGU Bangalore, dated 28-06-2017, have directed
- KEA to conduct Common Counselling for admission to UG Medical and Dental courses for all
- Government, Private (Including Minority), NRI and Others seats in the State of Karnataka. Centralised and Combined Counseling for the seats to be notified by the Karnataka State Government, in Government, COMED-K, KRLMPCA, AMPCK institutions, the admissions
- will be as per the Karnataka Selection of Candidates for Admission to Government Seats in Professional Educational Institutions Rules, 2006 (in short Rules) as amended from time to time and as per the guidelines of MCI / DCI / Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, GOI /
- Karnataka / Entrance Test Committee. 10. Mere qualifying in UGNEET-2021 does not confer any right on the candidate unless the candidate fulfils eligibility conditions / submission of certificates. Further, only the candidates who complete the registration process including document verification are eligible for Medical / Dental seats in Government / Private Colleges in Karnataka. Registered but not verified / Unregistered candidates will not be allowed for any admission either through KEA or

Government of India / Medical Education, Karnataka / Director Medical Education,

by the College, as after the mop-up round, the list of registered and verified but un-allotted candidates will be sent by KEA to colleges to fill-up vacant seats, if any. (As per GOI instructions) 11. For more details regarding academic eligibility / updates please visit KEA Website
