14 (*for instance, hence, moreover, in short*)

-----, she concludes that the blend of the best aspects from American system of education and Indonesian system of education could be followed in schools.

Sophia believes that innovation without knowledge is incomplete.

-----, she argues that both knowledge and creativity are equally important.

----- creativity without knowledge paves way for confusion.

15 (*despite, as, furthermore, also*)

----- the vet had warned about the result of another miscarriage.

----- the knowledge about the sickness of his buffalo, Kashi didn't hesitate to sell his animal.

Poverty has had its effect on Kashi and ----- on the old man.

Kashi was forced to do it ----- his wife was a cancer patient.
